

HANDICAP RULES AND PROCEDURES

Actual handicaps are calculated and maintained by the League's software program as follows:

1 to 3 scores - average handicap from all scores.

4 or more rounds - from the last four rounds the highest score will be dropped and the handicap will be calculated from the remaining three scores.

For handicap purposes only, maximum score per hole is three (3) over par.

Maximum handicap is limited to 36.

For new members your initial handicap will be as stated on the application form.

If this not a GHIN index the starting maximum handicap for those playing from the Regular tees will be 20 and the starting maximum for those playing from the Senior's tees will be 25. For non-GHIN handicap players this initial handicap will be used until the player has completed three handicap calculating rounds after which handicap will be calculated as stated, above.

For returning members, scores from the previous year will be used to calculate handicap as described, above.
